Today, kids are getting cell phones earlier and earlier. My granddaughter, who is two, sees my phone and wants to look at the pictures. She knows how to swipe left or right to get a new picture. My other granddaughter likes to take pictures with my phone when we visit the zoo; some of the pictures turn out pretty good.

There are certainly good reasons for having your child have a cell phone, but with anything our children have there is a degree of responsibility that we, as adults, need to monitor. Do you know what your kids are doing on their phone? Are they simply using it for emergencies, or are they using it to post things on social media that are not appropriate? Are they searching the internet? Maybe looking at videos they shouldn't be? Are they using it to hurt other people? Are they looking at their phone so intently that they fail to look up from their phone to have a conversation with you?

Please understand that I am not saying students should not have a cell phone. I am reminding all of us to monitor what your student is doing on their phone. There are some good things that a student can be using a cell phone for, but unfortunately there are many bad things.

If you have students with cell phones, please make sure you are monitoring their use closely and reviewing the expectations of cell phone use with your student. If your student does not have a cell phone yet, decide now when you may allow your student to have a phone and the expectations that go along with having a cell phone.
