It's that time of year when we need to be prepared for *Emergency School Closings!* To make sure you are notified of any closings or emergency changes in schedules, please make sure you are signed up with our emergency notification system (one call now). If you have not signed up -- simply go to <http://www.mycallnow.com> first time users click the sign up button and follow ALL the prompts/directions. You **must verify your phone # as well as your email address** and link to our school for notifications from us. When searching for our school you should **search by zip code and enter 60148.** (we are listed as St John's Lutheran Church and School).

If we were to call a snow day you will receive notification through this system. We would also use the **Emergency Closing System** as seen on WGN --so you could look for our name scrolling on the list of school closings.

After notifying families through One Call Now, and Emergency Closing System, we will post to social media and send a blast email.
